UNDERTAKING AND CONSENT

1. This Undertaking and Consent is made pursuant to s. 36 of the *Health Professions Act* (the "Act") regarding the investigation of the complaints of [an insurance company] and of [a patient].
2. Dr. Wiebe acknowledges that complaints have been made and the College has concerns with his billing practices and with the quality of care provided to [a patient] and to certain patients whose charts were reviewed in connection with the [insurance] complaint.
3. Dr. Wiebe undertakes not to engage in the conduct which was the subject matter of the [insurance] complaint, which includes rendering accounts and receiving payment for treatment to patients when: 1) there was insufficient evidence that the treatment charged for was provided, or, 2) if treatment was provided, it was not required by the patient.
4. Dr. Wiebe undertakes and agrees that he will not apply to the College for reinstatement of practising registration until two years from the date that this Undertaking and Consent is approved by a Panel of the Inquiry Committee. For the purposes of this Undertaking and Consent, "practising registration" refers to any registration status that permits a registrant to engage in the practice of dentistry.
5. Dr. Wiebe further undertakes and agrees that, prior to applying for reinstatement of practising registration in accordance with this Undertaking and Consent, he must demonstrate to the Inquiry Committee of the College that he has successfully completed an ethics course acceptable to the College, such as the 3-day Professional/Problem Based Ethics Program (PROBE) offered by the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians.
6. Dr. Wiebe acknowledges and agrees that if he applies for reinstatement of practising registration in accordance with this Undertaking and Consent,
 - (a) his application will be addressed by the Registration Committee in accordance with the *Act* and the Bylaws of the College;
 - (b) in addition to any requirements, limits or conditions imposed by the Registration Committee, his practice will be subject to the following conditions:

- (i) he must complete an educational program including courses or study clubs and/or a mentorship dealing with diagnosis and treatment planning, informed consent, prosthodontic treatment, endodontic treatment, periodontic treatment and ethics, being the following or reasonable equivalent:
 - (A) Review of the College's "Tough Topics" DVD on informed consent and satisfactory completion of the post-test;
 - (B) Either attendance for two years in a hands-on prosthodontics study club, approved by the College, that includes components in periodontics and diagnosis and treatment planning or, instead of the study club, a mentorship of at least 8 half-days by a mentor acceptable to the College dealing with diagnosis and treatment planning, informed consent, prosthodontic treatment, periodontic treatment and ethics; and
 - (C) A 2-3 day hands-on course in endodontics, approved by the College;
 - (ii) [redacted to protect Dr. Wiebe's privacy];
 - (iii) that his practice will be subject to monitoring by the College for a period of three (3) years.
7. Dr. Wiebe acknowledges that the College will notify the complainants of the disposition of their complaints pursuant to s. 36(1.1) of the *Act* and that the complainants have a right to a review of the disposition by the Health Professions Review Board.
8. Dr. Wiebe understands and agrees that this Undertaking and Consent is made with respect to a "serious matter" as that term is defined in the *Act* and that named publication is presumptively required pursuant to s. 39.3 of the *Act*.
9. Dr. Wiebe is entitled to make an application to the Inquiry Committee for a direction that publication should be partially withheld, pursuant to section 39.3(4) of the *Act*; however, regardless of the outcome of any application to withhold publication:
- (a) Dr. Wiebe remains bound by the terms of this Undertaking and Consent;
 - (b) The College's obligation to notify other regulatory bodies pursuant to College Bylaw 10.05 is unaffected; and
 - (c) The College may provide information regarding this matter to any dental regulatory body to whom Dr. Wiebe applies for registration.

10. Dr. Wiebe has entered into this Undertaking and Consent with the advice of legal counsel and is aware of his rights and responsibilities.
