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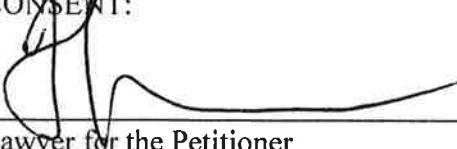
ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, coming on for hearing, at Vancouver, British Columbia, on Friday, the 20th day of February 2026, and on hearing Jeffrey Hernaez, counsel for the petitioner, and no one else appearing despite being duly served;

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. The respondent is enjoined and restrained, so long as he is not a registrant of the British Columbia College of Oral Health Professionals (“**College**”) who is a dentist, from practicing dentistry, pursuant to s. 52(1) of the *Health Professions Act*, RSBC 1996 c 183 (the “**Act**”).
2. The respondent is further enjoined and restrained from:
 - a. using titles “dentist”, “dental surgeon”, “surgeon”, “doctor”, or “dental therapist”, any abbreviation of those titles, and any equivalents or abbreviations of the titles in another language: (i) to describe his work; (ii) in association with or as part of another title describing his work; or (iii) in association with a description of their work; or
 - b. using any name, title, description, or abbreviation of a name or title, or an equivalent of a name or title in another language, in a manner that expresses or implies that they are entitled to practice dentistry or are associated with the College;unless he is at the time of such use a registrant of the College who is a dentist.

3. The respondent is further enjoined and restrained from recovering any fee or remuneration in respect of the provision of a service that may be provided by a registrant of the College who is a dentist, unless at the time the respondent provided the service, he was a registrant of the College who is a dentist.
